- Support Indoor National Coaches and Athletes as required.
- Work alongside the National Performance Manager to coordinate the provision of performance analysis services and support to the national teams.
- Work alongside the National Performance Manager to provide data, analytics and game trends to the National Coaches to assist in the design and planning of the learning and practice environment.
- Work alongside the National Performance Manager to provide objective information through a range of performance data for national Coaches, athletes and the teams (capture, code, analysis and feedback) and program (benchmarking, forecasting and envisaging future performance progressions and evolutions).
- Contribute to effective communication to athletes and other key stakeholders to ensure effective operation of the program.
- Contribute to coach education seminars and workshops to increase the depth of the coaching pool and align national delivery expectations.
- Provide information and reports on athlete performance to the National Performance Manager.
- Develop and maintain strong relationships with home nations, international federations and other key stakeholders to support the achievement of program delivery.
