High Performance Beach Coaching

- Lead the Northern Ireland National Beach Pathway to provide appropriate training and competition experiences for selected athletes.
- Recruit athletes, coaches and support staff and effectively manage their development.
- Actively engage partnerships with other Federations and organisations to facilitate the programme along with additional athlete, and coach development opportunities.
- Develop a team of beach coaches to effectively identify high potential players. Identify, evaluate, select, recruit, and train network personnel on key processes and procedures.
- Support the creation and effective utilisation of feedback reports and personalised development plans for selected athletes.
- Engage with Commonwealth Games NI and structure the high-performance programme in line with CGNI targets and qualification for games.

Programme Management

- Responsible for delivering and managing the Northern Ireland Beach Tour and delivering events on budget
- Responsible for the development and implementation of resources through effective financial planning and management. Develop and monitor annual budgets.
- Support the development and implementation of reports to evaluate programme impact.
- Support requests for written and verbal reports for internal and external stakeholders and present information as requested.
- Support with the improvement, quality, and competitiveness of NI beach competitions.
- Identify opportunities to participate in high quality international tournaments and friendlies.

- Where possible deliver high quality, online learning experiences for athletes, coaches, and parents.
- Coordinate with Northern Ireland Volleyball to create and develop a meaningful and engaging beach programme.
- Work with Sport Northern Ireland to improve coach education opportunities both in person and online.
